It is the only vehicle that comes with factory fitted air intake snorkel and manually operated, positive locking, mechanical differential locks on all four wheels.

The All-new Gurkha will be available in five attractive colours. A range of accessories like alloy wheels, all terrain tyres, roof- rack, etc., are on offer at the dealerships to make it adventure ready. The Gurkha 2021 comes with category best warranty of 1.5 lakh km/3 year and 4 free services. The Authorised dealerships have been prepared to cater to the Gurkha customers with dedicated service bays, customer lounge and company trained technicians.
