This plant is an important step in localization of high performance and premium quality engines for BMW India. A compact yet extremely modern facility with a high degree of attention to detail assures the highest quality and precise control on process parameters. The plant is completely air conditioned with high level of dust control to safeguard product quality. Where essential, most modern technology is employed for ensuring assembly and joinery processes with computer controlled precision equipment. The combination of the premium design of the engines, along with the best practices in production and testing processes, results in outstanding engines.

The plant can produce up to 20,000 premium engines per year. This capacity can be increased as needed. The IT system of the production facility is integrated in "Real Time" with the global production network of BMW. This enables all essential production process values to be integrated in BMW's global data.

Speaking on the occasion Mr. Prasan Firodia said, "This is an important milestone in the company's journey so far. We envision this facility as being instrumental in further establishing Force Motors' strengths as a preferred supplier of critical and high precision aggregates to top European brands."

The Force Motors plant at Chennai has been developed under supervision and guidance from the luxury car maker and is according to their exacting global standards. With the addition of this plant, the national presence of the group company goes up to fifteen facilities.
